### **OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Additional Funding Phase II Sewer Work: City administrator met with the engineer and contractor on the Phase II Wastewater Collection System Renovation. Administrator was informed that the contractor is finding bigger problems with the existing system and in order to fix them they will need to submit a change order which will include additional funding. There will need to be additional funding of \$1,066,000.00. Administrator Gress told council he had already spoke with Mike Billings with USDA to see if they could help with the additional funding. Motion was made by Rogers; seconded by Wood authorizing the administrator to move forward with completing the application for the additional funding. 6-0 Motion Carried

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. American Rescue Plan: Administrator Gress briefly discussed the Plan with council. Advised that he would keep them informed as he learned more. Right now, the government is still working on what and how this will need to be handled once they roll it. No Action Taken
- 2. Purposed Resolution: RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CANEY, KANSAS APPROVING A TEMPORARY PERMIT ALLOWING FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES ON CITY STREETS DURING THE 2021 MAYFEST KICKOFF CONCERT. Motion was made by Wood; seconded by Johnston to pass the resolution.

- 3. Swimming Pool Update: Administrator informed council that a leak detection company will be here on June 21<sup>st</sup> and June 22<sup>nd</sup> to work on finding the leak. However, the pool will have to be closed those two days while they are here. No Action Taken
- 4. Purchase of Furniture, Lifeguard Equipment, Small Freezer, etc. for Pool: Informed council that the city was in the process of purchasing items for the new pool to prepare for opening day. The lifeguards have been certified and employees are in place. No Action Taken
