## CODE ENFORCEMENT

## THE TOP TEN WAYS TO AVOID A VISIT FROM CODE ENFORCEMENT

- 1. **Mow your grass!** Grass or weeds must be kept to a length of less than eight (8) inches. This also includes landscaped areas.
- 2. Keep yard waste (grass, leaves, etc.) out of the street.
- 3. **Keep your vehicles** out of your own or neighboring yards and on a designated driveway. To be considered a driveway, it must be built out of concrete, asphalt, or, in rare cases, stone. Dirt doesn't count!
- 4. Keep your inside furniture inside and only use outside furniture outside.
- 5. Get proper building permits from Caney City Hall, 100 W. 4th Ave.
- 6. **Do not allow debris to accumulate** outside your home. Examples of debris are yard waste, appliances, furniture, and car parts. Putting a tarp over them doesn't make them invisible.
- 7. **All vehicles at your home must be currently plated and operational.** This includes vehicles parked in the street. Tarping a compliant vehicle is allowed, but tarps do not make noncompliant vehicles invisible.
- 8. **Put away your trash and recycling cans** on your pickup day. Do not put out televisions, computer equipment, or other electronics for trash pickup.
- Damaged pools and fences must be repaired or removed. Broken items such as windows, gutters, and soffits must be properly repaired.
- 10. Continue to mow your grass. THANK YOU!
