

ORDINANCE NO. 2146

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2015; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2124, AND ANY OTHER CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CANEY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of providing a comprehensive public offense code within the corporate limits of the City of Caney, Kansas, that certain uniform public offense code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2015, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than one (1) copy of the Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 2146", and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of the Uniform Public Offense Code similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION 2. That Ordinance No. 2124 and any other conflicting ordinances or parts thereof are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication, as provided by law.
